ACTION PLAN FOR THE MAGISTERIAL COURTS AT JORHAT FOR THE YEAR 2014

All the Courts of Judicial Magistrates of Jorhat including the Court of S.D.J.M.(M) Majuli, shall direct their activities as per this Action Plan to achieve the desired target and goal.

Sl. No.	Plan of Action	Course of Action	Remarks
1	Continuous effort shall be made to make zero pendency of five year old cases by 2014.	a) To identify the five year old cases. b) The cases shall be tied with a red ribbon so that the same can be easily identified. c) The issues in respect of service of processes in those cases will be discussed in the monthly meeting held with Dy. Commissioner and the Supdt. of Police. d) The issues in respect of service of processes shall also be discussed with the officers-in-charge of the police stations in the periodical meeting with Chief Judicial Magistrate. e) Special summons as per section 69 Cr.P.C. shall be issued through registered post, to the witnesses, in addition to the summons through normal course. f) One special drive in respect of old pending cases shall be taken from 17th of March to 31st of March, 2014. During this period, every Judicial Court shall make endeavour to examine at least thirty witnesses and a total number of 120 witnesses shall be examined by the existing four Magisterial Courts wherein such cases are pending. g) Co-operation from learned members of the Bar, specially the learned conducting lawyers of the parties of such proceeding, shall be sought for.
