This is for information of all concerned that we have been taking a special drive to speed up the trial of cases involving crimes against woman and maintenance proceedings pending in the Magisterial Courts of Jorhat including the Court of S.D.J.M. (M) Majuli. .

### Plan of Action.

- Giving priority to such cases but at the same time, the urgent matters and old pending and other categories of cases, as per the Action Plan of the Hon'ble High Court, shall not be ignored.
- Short dates shall be fixed in such cases and wherever possible evidence shall be posted on 2/3 consecutive dates.
- At least 8-10 cases of such nature, at different stages, shall be listed per day by each Court.
- The officers- in-charge of the police stations shall be asked to take special endeavour to server those summons.
- One special drive with effect from 16<sup>th</sup> of December, 2013 to 31<sup>st</sup> of December,2013, shall be taken up for speeding up the trial of such nature of cases.
- Issuing simultaneous summons to the witnesses through registered post as per section 69 of Cr.P.C.

### Object of the Special Drive and Target.

- The object of the special drive (w.e.f. 16/12/2013 to 31/12/2013) is to sensitize ourselves, e.g. Judicial Officers, in respect of speedy disposal of cases of such nature.
- To sensitize, make aware and motivate the other stake holders like Advocate, litigant public, witnesses, Police about the need of speedy disposal of such cases.
- The target is to examine 50 (fifty) witnesses per Court during that period and a total estimated target to examine 250(two hundred fifty) witnesses, by the existing five functional Magisterial Courts, including the Court of S.D.J.M.(M) Majuli and thereby accelerating the disposal of such cases.
