


**MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING OF THE TASK FORCE WITH THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, JORHAT AND SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE, JORHAT FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 2019 HELD ON 25/04/2019.**

In compliance of the Notification of Honourable Gauhati High Court (Notification No.52 dated 20/08/2013), monthly meeting, for the month of April,2019 was held on **25/04/2019** in the Office Chamber of District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat. The hon'ble District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat, the Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat, the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jorhat and Superintendent of Police, Jorhat have attended the meeting and discussed/consulted on the following matters.


1. The Hon'ble District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat at first pointed out that District Administration has not yet handed over encumbrance free land to Jorhat District Judiciary for the construction of the Judicial Court and Quarters at Titabar. Hon'ble Judge also informed that the matter has already been discussed in earlier meetings. To which the Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat informed that he would discuss the same with the Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat.
2. The Hon'ble District Judge, Jorhat also discussed about the handing over the room located in between the District and Sessions Judge Establishment and Chief Judicial Magistrate Establishment, Jorhat. To which the Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat informed that he would discuss the same with the Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat.
3. The Hon'ble District Judge, Jorhat also informed that the Crime Conference needs to be held early. The Superintendent of Police, Jorhat informed that the same may be held tentatively on 25/05/2019.
4. The Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jorhat also informed the Superintendent of Police, Jorhat that in some cases, it has been found that, after completion of investigation, I/O files F.R. Along with the F.R, I/O also files a case under section 211 of IPC. Unless the F.R is accepted by court, on the complaint case registered, on protest petitioner is finally dispose of, it cannot be said that the case filed by the informant is without any reasonable or sufficient ground, and hence, no case should be filed, against the informant of the case. To which the Superintendent of Police, Jorhat assured that he would look into the matter.
