

**MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING OF THE JUDICIAL OFFICERS WITH THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, JORHAT AND SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE, JORHAT FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER, 2016 HELD ON 21/12/2016.**

In compliance of the Notification of Honourable Gauhati High Court (Notification No.52 dated 20/08/2013), monthly meeting, for the month of December'2016, was held on 18/11/2016 in the Office Chamber of District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat. The honourable District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat, the Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat, Superintendent of Police, Jorhat, and other Ld.Judicial officers of Jorhat have attended the meeting and discussed/consulted on the following matters.

1. The Hon'ble District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat at first pointed out that the crime conference needs to be organized urgently which is very much necessary to keep the police up to date regarding the latest changes in law and to meet the requirement of various cases during investigation to which Superintendent of Police assured that the same will be held in consultation with the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Jorhat in the month of January,2017.
2. The Hon'ble District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat also requested the Addl. D.C, Jorhat to do the needful in removing the garbage bin which was again placed beside the court building, to which the Addl. D.C assured to do the same. Also, it is requested to take necessary steps to keep the campus of the Judicial Court Building clean, to which the Addl. D.C assured that he would do the needful in this regard. The Addl. D.C, Jorhat also advised that the aforesaid matter also needs to be informed to the Chairman/Executive officer, Jorhat Municipal Board and P.W.D (Building Division) separately by the District Judiciary, so that they may inspect the site on regular basis for the needful action. In addition, the Addl. D.C assured to allot two person to take care of the B.R Ambedkar garden.
3. The Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge also informed the Addl. D.C to take necessary steps in placing a garbage bin outside the campus of the RCC Building (Judicial Quaters) without creating nuisance to the surrounding, to which the Addl. D.C assured to do the needful.
