




MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING OF THE TASK FORCE WITH THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, JORHAT AND SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE, JORHAT FOR THE MONTH OF JULY, 2019 HELD ON 06/07/2019


In compliance of the Notification of Honourable Gauhati High Court (Notification No.52 dated 20/08/2013), monthly meeting, for the month of July,2019 was held on **06/07/2019** in the Office Chamber of District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat. The Hon'ble District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat, the Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat, the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jorhat and Superintendent of Police, Jorhat have attended the meeting and discussed/consulted on the following matters.

1. The Hon'ble District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat at first pointed out that the present plot which has been decided by the District Administration to be handed over to Jorhat judiciary for the construction of the Judicial Court and Quarters at Titabar is not suitable as the same is located far away from the S.D.O Office at Titabar. It was also discussed during the meeting to have a plot for the aforesaid purpose, preferably, within the vicinity of the existing S.D.O Office at Titabar. To which, the Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat informed that he is familiar to the concerned area where the plot of land is being sought for and would look into the matter in order to hand over a plot as discussed.
2. The Hon'ble District Judge, Jorhat also informed that in pursuance of Hon'ble Gauhati High Court's Letter No. HC.VII-44/2018/3025/A, Dated. 4.06.2019, it is required to allot appropriate land preferably within **5 K.M** radius from the Judicial Court Building at Jorhat. To which, the Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat informed that he would look into the matter.
3. The Hon'ble District Judge, Jorhat informed the Superintendent of Police, Jorhat to take necessary measures in carrying out investigation of cases related to ST/SC (Prevention of Atrocity) as per the provisions of the said act. The Superintendent of Police, Jorhat assured compliance of the same.
4. The Hon'ble District Judge, Jorhat also informed the Superintendent of Police, Jorhat to take necessary action for proper and timely services of summons and notices. The The Superintendent of Police, Jorhat informed that he would look into the matter.
