



**MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING OF THE TASK FORCE WITH THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER,
JORHAT AND SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE, JORHAT FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 2018 HELD ON
29/03/2019.**

In compliance of the Notification of Honourable Gauhati High Court (Notification No.52 dated 20/08/2013), monthly meeting, for the month of March,2019 was held on **29/03/2019** in the Official Chamber of District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat. The hon'ble District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat, the Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat, the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jorhat and Superintendent of Police, Jorhat have attended the meeting and discussed/consulted on the following matters.


1. At first the Hon'ble District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat enquired about the handing over of encumbrance free land for the construction of Judicial Court and Quarters at Titabar, which was already discussed in the monthly meeting dated. 29.09.2018 and as resolved a letter had been issued to then Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat (JJA/8313/18, dated 29/10/2018).To which the Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat informed that she would look into the matter and if required, she may take necessary steps to allot a different plot, for the said purpose.
2. The Hon'ble District Judge, Jorhat informed the Superintendent of Police, Jorhat to take necessary measure for speedy and timely investigation of cases in connection with POCSO act. To which, he assured the compliance of the same and informed that only 8 (eight) cases are pending at present, which are very recent.
3. The Hon'ble Judge, Jorhat also informed the Superintendent of Police, Jorhat to held Crime Conference regularly, to which Superintendent of Police, Jorhat informed that the same may be held tentatively after "Bohag Bihu" vacations.
4. The Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jorhat also informed Superintendent of Police, Jorhat that many cases are not charge sheeted, specifically for some petty cases. The Superintendent of Police, Jorhat informed immediate measures would be taken for the same.
5. Further, the Hon'ble District Judge, Jorhat he stated that the room located in the first floor of the Judicial Court Building Jorhat, which falls in between the establishment of District and Sessions Judge, Jorhat and Chief Judicial Magistrate Jorhat may be allotted to District Judiciary to accommodate the staff of Jorhat District Judiciary and which perhaps is used by the District Administration, Jorhat. The Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat informed that she would look into the matter.


