Proceeding of weekly meeting of Judicial Officers of Jorhat District Judiciary held through video conferencing at 4.15 pm., on 19.01.2022.

**Agenda Items:**

**1. Discussion on postponement of Lok Adalat-**

In today's meeting discussion was made in regard to the postponement of the Lok-Adalat due to rising cases of Covid-19, which was supposed to be held on 22.01.2022. The Hon'ble District and Sessions judge, Jorhat asked that as already cases were fixed and notice were sent, it is necessary to notify the litigants about the postponement of the Lok Adalat. Therefore, the Secretary D.L.S.A, Jorhat and the Secretary D.L.S.A, Majuli were directed to take necessary steps regarding that matter and circulate out this information through various means of media and also asked the other judicial officers to put notice outside their respective Courts.

The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate had informed in the meeting that he had already taken step regarding notification of postponement of the Lok Adalat.

**2. Discussion on vaccination-**

In the second agenda, discussion was made in regard to vaccination of Booster dose for Judicial Officers. The Hon'ble District and Sessions judge, Jorhat stated that whoever voluntarily wants to take the booster dose can take the vaccine but it has to be ensured that if the time span between the second dose and booster dose has to be 9 months or if it is permissible to take the booster dose by the front line workers prior to the time period of 9 months. It is to be further ensured if the Judicial Officers are under the purview of front line workers.

**3. Discussion on leave of employees-**

As in the current Covid situation, cases are rising rapidly, the District and Sessions judge, Jorhat asked the Judicial Officers not to be

rigid regarding leave permission to the employees of the establishment on the ground of medical urgency.

**4. Discussion on Celebration of Republic day-**

There was further discussion regarding the Celebration of Republic day. The Hon'ble District and Sessions judge, Jorhat suggested to celebrate the Republic day symbolically and with minimum gathering with compliance to the prescribed Covid Protocol at Jorhat, Titabor and Majuli.

**5. Discussion on other matter-**


The Learned S.D.J. M, Jorhat had asked if the Hazira, petitions could be dispensed as the present Covid situation at Jorhat is worsening, The Hon'ble District and Sessions judge, Jorhat asked the Judicial Officers to dispense the Hazira, petitions at their own discretion, if the parties are present or the parties are absent and their Counsel verbally submits to represent them as a preventive measure against covid-19.




